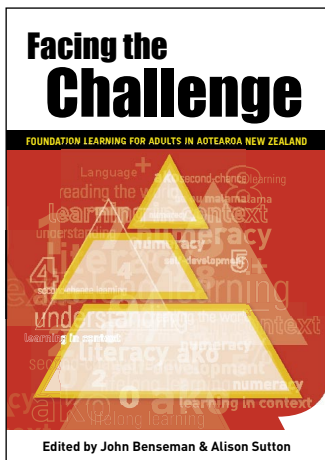


FACING THE CHALLENGE

It covers the major skill areas in foundation learning, including literacy, numeracy, English for Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL) and information and computer technology (ICT). It also examines teaching and learning in different contexts (including polytechnics, the community and workplace) and looks at equivalent systems in the UK. The experiences of learners are also considered, in particular those who are Māori or Pasifika.

The book strikes a balance between theoretical perspectives and concepts and practical descriptions and analysis of real-life teaching and learning issues. It will be useful to both new and experienced practitioners.
