





## Resources for new adult and tertiary

#### teachers

- Ako Aotearoa, The National Center for Tertiary Teaching and Learning Excellence
- 3 funding grants: (1) 2008: needs analysis for novice teachers, review existing options, develop *Signposts* (2) 2010: national evaluation of usefulness and current applications, and strategies expansion and improvement; (3) 2012: a follow-on resource, *Goalposts*, an introduction to theories and principles of adult learning and education
- Each phase peer-review, field pilots, panel review








#### Why did we propose GoalPosts?


- Focus on student Learning and the principles and theories to assist new adult and tertiary teachers linking practice and theory (SoLT)
- We need to know why as well as how and use evidence to improve our practice.
- Simple easily accessible style distilled from wide literature review and key stakeholder feedback




#### What have we covered?

- Introduction to adult learning theories; not designed to replace tertiary teaching qualification
- Focus on distilling information to "bite sized" chunks
- Practical focus with lots of "how to" including, glossary and examples of strategies for use shared collected across our sector.


#### Who did we ask?
